Year 1	1 hour a week And 5 x of reading (minimum of 10 minutes a session)	 ENGLISH Daily reading - please continue to aim to read daily to your child as well as hearing them read and discussing their reading book with them using VIPERS questions found in the reading diary. A guided book (already read in guided reading) will be sent home and they will have a choice book to read in class. Phonics - each week, you will receive phonics information linked to the learning your child has been doing in school so that you can support your child by practising their reading and spelling using these sounds. MATHS Mathletics tasks linked to their learning in class. TOPIC CURRICULUM Choice of activities in a half termly 'home learning passport' shared via Teams. These will be set as assignments on Teams, children can choose an activity to complete each week which we ask you to share with us via Teams account. Online platforms: Mathletics, Spelling Shed and Purple Mash to support their weekly learning. 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Year 2	1 hour a week And a minimum of 10 minutes, 5 times a week, of reading	 ENGLISH Daily reading - please continue to read daily to your child as well as hearing them read and discussing their reading book with them using VIPERS questions found in the reading diary. Please note in the reading diary when you read with your child. Your child will bring home 1 reading book home a week. Please ensure this book and reading diary are bought to and from school everyday. Phonics - each week, you will receive phonics information linked to the learning your child has been doing in school so that you can support your child by practising their reading and spelling using these sounds. Spelling - each week spelling tasks will be set on Spelling Shed linked to previous learning in class. Play the games to practise the spelling. MATHS Mathletics - each week maths tasks will be set on Mathletics linked to previous learning in class. Have a go at the activities to practise the key concepts. Times Tables - Practise your times tables (1, 2, 5, 10) on Timestable Rockstars as you collect coins to spend in the virtual shop. TOPIC CURRICULUM Choice of activities in a half termly 'home learning passport' shared via Teams. These will be set as assignments on Teams, children can choose an activity to complete each week which we ask you to share with us via Teams account. During this term, the children will also be encouraged to use our online platform Purple Mash to support their weekly learning. 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Years 3/4	1 1/2 hours a week	 Reading - please read with and to your children for minimum of 4 20minute sessions weekly. Please use the VIPERS prompts to discuss the text with your child. children will have a reading book in school which they will take an Accelerated reader quiz on when finished. Weekly spellings which can be practiced on Spelling Shed. Some of these maybe tricky words that do not follow the spelling patterns that we learn in lessons. They may be informally tested on these words during the half term to give them feedback on their own learning. The children will receive and each half term they will also be given a list of spellings to learn. 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Years 5/6	2 hours a week	• Reading – please encourage your child to read regularly minimum of 4 20minute sessions weekly. Children will have a book chosen from the library which is within their reading range. We would encourage the children to have a varied reading diet both at home and school. They will be able to quiz books they have read at home as long as they are on the Accelerated Reader site. Please discuss their book with them, these VIPERS prompts may be useful. • Weekly spelling practice on Spelling Shed and each half term they will also be given a list of nonstandard spellings to learn. These words are tricky words that do not follow the spelling patterns that we learn in lessons. They may be informally tested on these words during the half term to give them feedback on their own learning. MATHS • 1 × weekly maths linking to learning which will reflect the work they have been doing in the class at that time through Mathletics. If there is any additional time, they can access their Times Table Rockstar account to practise their times tables. TOPIC CURRICULUM • There is a weekly choice for Topic which will be set on Teams.
