Vocabulary

A canon	A canon is a piece of music in which two or more voices (or instrumental parts) sing or play the same music starting at different times.
A duet	When one tune fits with another tune, we call the music a duet
Slurred notes	A slur joins two notes together smoothly- tongue the first note but not the second
Tied notes	When two notes are tied together, do not play the second note



Copy-Cat Fanfare

The music for Group A copies Group B when this happens we call it a canon.
