Play instruments made out of recycled materials at home <i>Experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related elements of music</i> Explore and describe sounds using elements vocabulary- dynamics, duration, pitch	Use home-made instruments to accompany songs <i>Play untuned instruments musically</i> Sing songs learnt during the term and accompany with made instruments Perform and record

Call and response	A succession of two different phrases
duration	Long and short sounds
Rhythm	A sequence of short and long sounds
accompaniment	Playing instruments as you sing a song
