Rules help us to know how we are expected to behave. If we do, not follow the rules then there will be consequences.</p> <p>The Golden Rules:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We are gentle • We try our best • We are honest • We listen • We are kind and helpful • We look after property
What responsibilities do I have at school?	What is meant by the term 'voting'?
<p>It is important that we all take responsibility for helping around the classroom. This will help to ensure that the classroom stays tidy and that the resources are kept in good condition.</p> <p>Some things we can do to help include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tucking chairs in • Hanging school jumpers and cardigans on your peg so that they do not get lost • Closing doors behind you • Pick things off the floor • Hand in your home learning book on the correct day 	<p>Voting is a fair way of choosing something.</p> <p>Examples of voting in school may be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Voting on which book you would like the teacher to read. Everyone puts their hand up and the book that receives the most votes wins! • Voting for a school council member. We listen to the children's reasons as to why they would be a good member and then we put up our hands to show which child we think would be best. The child who receives the most votes wins!



Key Vocabulary:	
Responsibility	To be accountable and to have control over something.
Rules	A set of guidelines designed to keep us happy and safe.
Consequences	Something that will happen if you do not follow the rules E.g. get a warning, go to the Talking Point
Voting	The process of choosing/making a decision fairly.
