Some people believe in God and that God is very important in the lives of these people even though God cannot be seen. Christian people believe the world would not function without God. Christians believe in God as the Creator of all who sees and knows everything. Christian usually call God "Lord" or "Father". He is seen to be all powerful, loving and forgiving. Christians believe that they must be loyal and obedient to the commandments of God as found in the Bible
<p>How does Sunday worship increase faith in Christian families?</p> <p>Christians believe god created the world in seven days and on the seventh day God rested. Sunday (the seventh day) became the principal day of worship for Christians.</p> <p>Different denominations may worship in different ways in their home and in churches.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quakers will participate in silent prayer, Methodists like to study the Bible Mass or Holy Communion are important to Catholics and Anglicans. <p>Some Christian families show their faith in God and Jesus at home in different ways.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Saying grace before meals, Wearing a cross as an item of jewelry Car stickers in the sign of a fish in the window. Singing songs and hymns helps people with their faith. 	<p>Why is it important to rest and have peace in the week?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sunday is when Christian people attend Church and take time to rest and be with their families. Sunday is different to the other days of the week. The shops are not open the same times as other days. Some families go to church. Sunday lunch is also important to a family. 
<p>What other things do Christians celebrate or remember that show faith in Jesus?</p> <p>Christians celebrate a range of different festivals throughout the year such as Lent, Easter, Christmas.</p>	<p>What else is important to a Christian family?</p> <p>Jesus used to pray and encouraged followers to pray regularly.</p>

Vocabulary	
Christians	People who believe in the teachings of Jesus.
God	In the Christian church God is the creator and ruler of the universe.
Jesus	The son of God.
Belonging	Is a sense of fitting in or feeling like you are an important part of a group.
Quaker	The Quakers are a group of Christians who use no scripture and believe in great simplicity in daily life and in worship.
Methodist	Methodists are Protestant Christians who follow the teachings of John Wesley and who have their own branch of the Christian church and their own form of worship.
Catholic	Catholics follow the teachings of Jesus Christ but do so through the church, whom they consider as the path to Jesus.
Anglican	Relating to or denoting the Church of England or any Church in communion with it.
