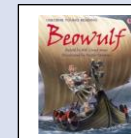

In **English** next week, we will be continuing to look at the story of Beowulf, the children will be looking at using direct speech and how to write an action sequence.

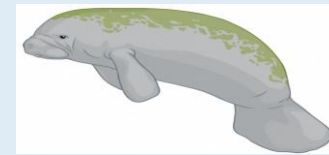
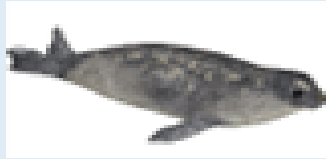

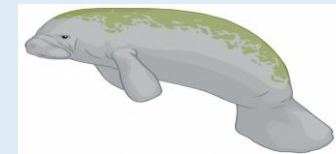
