EYFS and Year 1

What is expected by the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage		I can say what I want to write out loud before I write it.
		I can sound talk each word before I write it.
		I can hold a pencil comfortably. I can form recognisable letters. I can form letters correctly.
		I can write independently.
		I can put finger spaces between my words.
		I can use full stops at the end of sentences.
		I can read my sentence and check that it makes sense. I can read my sentence to an adult or another child.
What is expected by the end of Year 1 (In addition to EYFS)		I can spell words containing each of the letter sounds I have been taught. I can spell some high frequency words.
		I can use joining words like 'and'.
		I can use capital letters at the start of a sentence.
		I can join my sentences together to make a story.
		My writing is interesting.
