

Meeting Individual Needs



We support and value the abilities of all our pupils at Waterbeach. It is our duty to provide equal opportunities for every person in our care in a safe and well-equipped learning environment which caters to the needs of every child as an individual. We are committed to inclusion in the school curriculum and through participation in all aspects of school life.

Our highly-skilled teaching assistants provide in class support and challenge for all pupils. Small group teaching and 1:1 teaching are used to support some pupils in overcoming barriers to learning.

Our Inclusion Manager, Mrs Scrivner, works closely with pupils, staff, families and external agencies to tailor the support pupils might need.

During your child's first year of school, we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework and at the end of the year, children are assessed against a set of Early Learning Goals.

Home Visits

At the beginning of the autumn term we start by making home visits. These are great opportunity for you and your child to meet their teacher before starting school, share information about your child and give you a chance to ask any questions you may have.

Stay and Play

We also offer a chance for you and your child to visit the school in one of our hour long Stay and Play sessions following the Home Visits. This is an opportunity for you to join your child exploring their new classroom together.

Half Days

Your child will then begin school by coming in for shorter half day sessions with only half of their class. This builds over the course of around a week to full-time with the whole of their class.

Parent Partnership



At Waterbeach School, we value our relationships between parents, carers and staff. This is especially important at these early stages of your child's development.

- Home visits
- Parent consultations
- Tapestry

You can also arrange a time to come and speak to your child's class teacher if any concerns arise. You can talk or email your child's class teacher or call the office to arrange these meetings.

How to help your child get ready for school



- Manage toilet routine independently
- Wash and dry their hands
- Put on and attempt/try to fasten their own coat
- Put shoes on the correct feet (stickers are good for learning)
- Dress and undress into PE kit
- Listen and follow simple instructions
- Tidy up and put things away when they have finished with them
- · Answer people correctly using 'please' and 'thank you' when appropriate
- Hold a pencil comfortably to draw
- Use a knife and fork to cut food and eat food
- Wait their turn for things
