Je – I Tu – you Il/elle – he/she Nous – we Vous – you (polite) Ils/ells - they	Regular verbs are called “regular” because the verb endings linked to each personal pronoun stays the same, they are “regular” Irregular verbs – the endings change for each personal pronoun and have to be learnt as there is no pattern to follow.
