Week Beginning 22.1.24 Our Topic is... We Can All Be Heroes

A huge thank you to all the parents who have come into school to speak to the children about their occupation so far and for all the fantastic Tapestry posts too. It has been brilliant to share these with the children and we have had some very interesting discussions about different jobs ©

Next week, we will be learning about...

Topic: We will be continuing our topic learning about Real Life Superheroes next week and focusing on the emergency services. We will read a book 'Emergency Vehicles' to help us find out about firefighters and police officers. We have visits from police officers and a fire fighter scheduled which will be very exciting! On Thursday we will be joining the whole school in 'Conflict Resolution Day' and will explore what happens if we have a disagreement with a friend, how this makes us feel and what we could say to resolve the conflict.

Phonics: We will be continuing our phonics teaching with the new Phase 3 phonemes *ur*, *ow*, *oi* and *ear*. We will be sending out the new phonemes for the week on Monday. Please cut these out and stick them in your child's phonics home learning book. We will be practising the tricky words *my*, *by* and *all*.

Maths: We will be learning all about the number 8! We will continue to strengthen our subitising skills to see five and then look for how many more. Eight is five and three more. We will use a part whole model to represent eight in different ways and practise writing the numeral 8.

How you could help your child:

 Practise the new phonemes sent home, including practising writing them in the phonics home learning book.
