Week Beginning 18.3.24 Our Topic is... The World Around Us

Next week, we will be learning about...

Topic: We will be learning the story of The Little Red Hen and practising retelling the story with actions. We will also be thinking about the characters in the story and using our imagination to write a letter to one of the characters. We will be using our hammering skills to make hedgehogs in Woodwork and we will also be making campfire bread in Forest School.

Phonics: We will be consolidating our learning in Phonics this week. We will be reviewing longer words and words with the 's' grapheme making a |z| or an |s| sound (e.g. *visit* and *sing*) and words ending in -es making an |iz| sound (e.g. *torches* and *wishes*). We will also be reviewing the tricky words: they, all, by, my, are, sure, pure.

Maths: We will be extending our learning about addition to thinking about double numbers. We will watch the Numberblocks episode "Double Trouble" to help us understand the concept. We will use the STEM sentence "double <u>__</u> is <u>__</u>" e.g. "double 2 is 4".

How you could help your child:

- Keep practising the Phase 3 phonemes that have been sent home this half term, including practising writing them in the phonics home learning book.
- Enjoy reading your child's choice book and decodable book with them over the weekend.

Reminders
