Week Beginning 15.04.24 Our Topic is...

How does your garden grow?

After the break, we will be learning about...

Topic: We are very much looking forward to beginning our new Topic in the first week back after the Easter Holidays! We will be focussing on the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We will be using the story to think about what plants need to grow, taking part in a cress experiment and planting our own sunflowers! In PSHE we will be learning to recognise the clues our bodies give us when we are feeling unsafe or unsure.

Phonics: In Phonics we will be learning to read and write CVCC (consonant, verb, consonant, consonant) words containing short vowels. We will also be learning new tricky words: said, so, have and like. We will continue to practise our phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.

Maths: In Maths, we will begin learning about subtraction. We will introduce the children to subtraction when a quantity is decreased by an amount and use 'stories' to help us with this. E.g. first there were 5 counters, then we subtracted/took away 1, now there are 4 left. We will use this knowledge to solve simple subtraction calculations and practise the STEM sentences, for example: 5 minus 1 equals 4 and 5 minus 1 is 4.
