Dear parents and carers,

Year 3: Thorpe Woodlands Centre: Thursday 20th and Friday 21st March

The children in Year 3 (in September) have the opportunity to go to Thorpe Woodlands for a multi-activity adventure day. We have decided this year, we have booked places on Thursday 20th and Friday 21st March, **nearer the time we will let you know which classes are going on which days.** It is hoped that the children will take part in Big Swing, Archery and Team Challenges. The actual selection of activities is dependent upon the suitability of the weather. No activity will take place in unsuitable conditions.

The total cost of the activity day will be £50.00; this covers the whole day at the Centre and transport. A deposit of £10.00 will secure your child's place in the first instance, deposit by Friday, 12th July 2024 on our on line payment system School Gateway so that we can let the Centre know how many places we will need. The balance can then be spread over the next few months. We realise that this is a large amount of money, but we are convinced that the range and quality of this day will make it excellent value (and great fun!).

The day will run from 10.00am to 4.00pm, leaving school as soon as possible at 8.30am and returning at approximately 5.00pm, please ensure that your child is met at this time.

The school continues to take children on day trips which are thoroughly enjoyed by the children and which are a desirable part of their education. The 1988 Education Act specifies that any activity which takes place during school time must be free although there is no ban on requesting voluntary contributions. **If you would like your child to take part in this visit, but are not sure that you can make the full contribution, please write to me as soon as possible.**
