Dear Parents/Carers,

The weather may have been different, but this hasn't dampened the children. The children have been learning all about position and direction, they have been practising turning a full turn, half turn, quarter turn and three-quarter turn. They have also been practising their left and right and the language above, below, forward and backwards. In English, we have been exploring settings, the children created new settings for the boy and penguin characters, and then wrote sentences describing the setting.

Jump Up: **Monday 8th** and **Tuesday 9th** are transition days where the children will spend time in their new class with their new teachers. On Monday, children come to school to their Year 1 classroom and teachers will inform the children of their new classes and take them to meet their new teachers. At the end of the day children will be released from their Year 1 classroom door. Tuesday children will go their Year 2 classroom and be collected from their too. English:

We will explore what happened after the story **Lost and Found**. The children will use their imaginations and create their own sequels to the story.

Maths:

We will be learning doing some maths investigations. We will explore all the different ways to make 12 using the numbers provided. We will all do an investigation exploring what is the most common colour of smartie in a pack.
