

## Year 2 Weekly Learning Sharing – 13th September 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a fantastic week full of learning. The children have really enjoyed reading Hansel and Gretel and had a lot of questions about the different characters. They have also amazed us when representing 2-digit numbers; showing how many tens and ones a number has using lots of different resources.



We have also enjoyed learning about how homes have changed over time including thinking about our own houses. **Please could send in a photo or email us a photo of your house by Tuesday** (to your child's teacher) so that your child can use it as we compare our homes with those from the past.

**Indoor PE is on a Monday and Outdoor PE is on a Wednesday.** Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school and that any long hair is tied back and jewellery is removed.

**We will be going to the forest on Tuesday next week. Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> September.** Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

Your child's phonics reading book will be sent home today. These will always be sent home on a Friday and need to be returned on the following Monday. Please note that your child will not be sent a new book until they have returned the last one. **Please also enjoy reading your child's choice book with them and return this by Thursday so a new one can be chosen when we visit the schools library on a Thursday afternoon.**

**We would like to share our learning for next week with you. You may find it useful to discuss or practise the learning:**

Our **focus vocabulary** for the week is: **astounded, discovered, statement, question, command**

**Discuss these words with your child. How can they use them appropriately in a sentence and define their meaning?**

<b>English</b>	Next week we will be continuing our learning based around Hansel and Gretel. We shall continue to rehearse the story with our learnt actions – see if your child can remember parts at home. We shall be learning about 3 different sentence types, questions, commands and statements, and learn to identify these when they are said aloud or when we read them. Later in the week we will be recapping our learning on nouns, adjectives and verbs.
<b>Maths</b>	Next week we will be continuing to represent numbers up to 100. We will use blank part whole models to represent a 2 digit number alongside matching calculations. We will then complete partially filled part whole models, thinking about all the possibilities if there are only 3 ones given, for example. The tens part could be 0, 10, 20 etc to total a whole of 3, 13, 23 etc. We will also be using our reasoning skills to explain why and how a calculation is correct or incorrect.
