



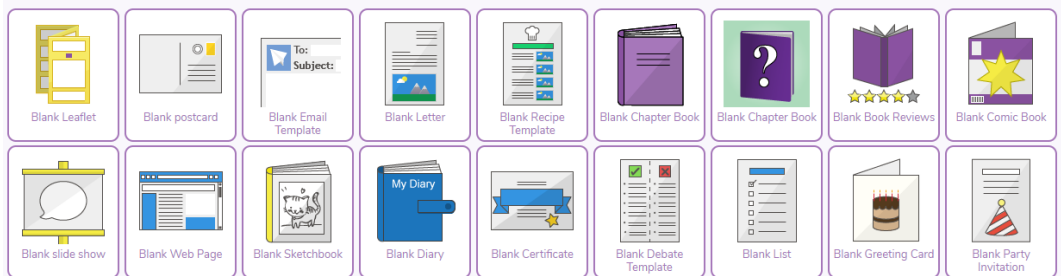

## Curriculum Capture for Year 4 Computing: Digital Literacy

### Theme: Writing for an Audience

Key Knowledge	
<b>How does font size and style affect the impact of a text?</b>	<b>How can I enhance my writing using computing?</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Changing the appearance of a font can make it easier to read or draw attention to specific parts that want highlighting.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children to take a recent piece of literacy work and to consider how they could enhance it by typing it up: making sub-headings clearer in an explanation text; using different page structures e.g. columns in a newsreport; or could they add colourful fonts to enhance a persuasive advert?</li> </ul>
<b>How should I change my writing for a news report?</b>	<b>How should I change my writing for a community campaign?</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Using 2Simulate on purple mash, children to be shown an imaginary news story. They can then write a short news report using one of the templates on 2Publish considering using large, bold fonts for a catchy headline, italics to highlight key information that they want to stand out etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children to create an information leaflet about a community campaign remembering key formatting in regards to font and page layout whilst also considering how to add in word art and images to make it more eye catching.</li> </ul>
