Vocabulary

Strumming:

First finger and thumb brush strums and shuffle strums

a way of playing a stringed instrument such as a guitar or ukulele; a sweeping action where a finger or thumbs brushes over several strings to generate sound.

Shuffle strums- down up strokes

fret

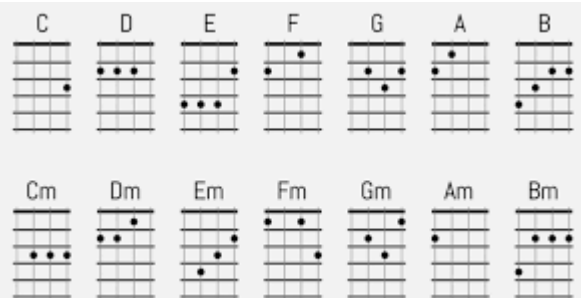
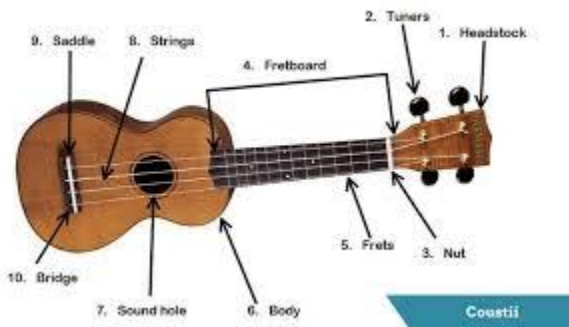
Strips of metal that go vertically across the strings-the higher the fret the higher the sound

chords

Several notes played together

Chord box

A diagram which shows where to press down to create a chord
