Dear Parents,

On Tuesday 5th May we will be visiting Thorpe Woodlands Adventure Centre. This letter contains important information about the equipment that your child will need for the day, as well as the timings for the trip.

For the trip, your child will need to wear long sleeved trousers that are easy to move around in (jogging bottoms or leggings would be ideal) as well as a long-sleeved top. A jumper/sweatshirt over a t-shirt will be suitable for this, but long sleeves are essential for one of the activities that the children will be doing whilst at the centre. A spare change of clothes, spare trainers and a small towel would be ideal as there are some water based activities.

They will also need a lightweight waterproof coat if it looks like it is going to be wet. Wellies will not be appropriate for this trip.

They will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle, please remember to include enough food to last the whole day as the children can get hungry on the way home. Their lunch and snacks need to be in a rucksack that they will carry themselves. If you would like a school packed lunch, please inform the office.

No cameras, phones, money or sweets should be brought on the trip.

Any child that usually requires a travel sickness tablet should take one before attending school and the tablet for the return journey must be in the original packaging and should be handed to their class teacher in a named envelope with instructions for timings.

Timings and Drop-off collection arrangements: The children will need to be dropped off at the gym entrance in the staff car park at **8:15am**. We will be returning to school at approximately **5.00pm**. Upon return, we will assemble the children altogether on the grassed area at the front of school before collecting. We would ask that all children have an adult to collect them, listed on their permissions information at the office. If any additional arrangements for your child's collection need to be made, can you please inform the office. We will need to check the children off on our return and as they are collected so please be patient with us. If there is a significant change to the collection time we will inform you.
