We will then move on to our new topic of measurement and learn how to measure and draw lines accurately to the nearest mm. We will end the week with a 'Sherlock Gnomes' investigation.

In English next week:

In English we will be basing our work on 'The Diary of a Killer Cat' by Anne Fine. Children will be learning to use adverbs to modify verbs, learning to use these at the beginning of a sentence and then consolidating their ability to write a dialogue.

In Spellings next week:

In spellings our words will focus on the 'ze' sound. The spellings words are: measure, treasure, pleasure, enclosure, displeasure, composure, leisure, exposure, closure, disclosure.
