In Spelling next week:

The children will be focussing on the words:

creature
furniture
picture
nature
adventure
capture
future
sculpture
fracture
mixture

In Maths next week:

We will be measuring and recording in mm and converting between cm and mm.

In English next week:

We will be learning about the structure of paragraphs and applying this within our own writing. We will be writing in role as a character from the story 'Diary of a Killer Cat'

In Science next week:

We will be setting up an investigation looking at how plants transport water. We will be working in groups to plan our science report focussing on equipment, method and our predictions.

In History next week:

We will be learning about the history of Denny Abbey. After our trip to the Farmland Museum at Denny Abbey, we will reflect on what we have learnt about the history of farming.
