


## Curriculum Capture for Year 1/2 Computing: Presenting Ideas

Key Knowledge	
<p><b>What do we need to think about when planning a presentation?</b></p> <p>The important thing to consider is the audience. Think about how old they are and what they would find interesting. For younger children, a presentation with pictures may be more appropriate.</p>	<p><b>Why should I plan out my presentation?</b></p> <p>Planning out your presentation allows you to make sure you have included all the information you need to. It is easier to do this in the planning phase rather than when you have started the presentation.</p>
<p><b>Making a Quiz using 2Quiz</b></p> <p>There are different ways to present questions in 2Quiz. You could use:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A multiple-choice question with two possible answers e.g. 'True' or 'False'.</li> <li>A multiple-choice question with four possible answers.</li> <li>A labelling question, matching the labels to an image.</li> <li>A text question with an image, where you type the answer in the answer box.</li> <li>A sequencing question- putting the images in the right order.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Making a Mind Map using 2Connect</b></p> <p>Mind maps can be very useful for organising your ideas, especially when a whole group of people get together to share ideas. You can then use the mind map to write a story or a report on the shared information.</p> <div style="text-align: center; margin-top: 20px;">  <p><b>Mind Map</b></p> </div>



Vocabulary	
Concept Map/ Mind Map	A tool for organising and representing knowledge. They form a web of ideas which are all interconnected.
Node	A way to represent a concept or idea using text and/or images.
Animated	A process by which we see still pictures appear to move.
Quiz	A test of knowledge, especially as a competition between individuals or teams as a form of entertainment.
Non-Fiction	Informative or factual writing.
Presentation	A speech or talk in which a new product, idea, or piece of work is shown and explained to an audience.
Narrative	A speech or talk in which a new product, idea, or piece of work is shown and explained to an audience.
Audience	The people giving attention to something
