#### Vocabulary

Call and response	a succession of two distinct phrases where the second phrase is heard in response to the first.
A didgeridoo	a <u>wind instrument</u> developed by <u>Aboriginal peoples</u> of northern Australia, likely within the last 1,000 years
A djembe drum	A djembe or jembe is a rope-tuned skin-covered goblet drum played with bare hands, originally from West Africa.
Reggae music	A style of popular music that originated in Jamaica in the late 1960s and quickly emerged as the country's dominant music. By the 1970s it had become an international style that was particularly popular in Britain, the United States, and Africa.
